Summer Arts Internship Program

The Summer Arts Internship Program is an unpaid internship for students who are currently in 8th – 12th grades, this school year. Summer Arts interns assist and work closely with one teacher, in four classes per day. Interns work with students from 3rd through 7th grades, with varying skills and abilities. Teachers give interns direction and instruction on how best they can help in the classroom. In addition, interns accompany the Summer Arts group on field trips, helping to facilitate a safe and fun experience for all.

The Summer Arts internship is a rare opportunity for high school students to gain hands-on experience in the teaching art field. The expectation is that Summer Arts interns will take their role seriously, be responsible and eager to help and learn, and come away with a very real understanding of what it takes to be a teaching artist. It will also be an excellent addition to a resume for future camp jobs and college applications.

Four interns are accepted per session. Only those students who can commit to an entire session on a daily basis will be accepted. The session dates are:

Session 1: June 21 – June 30, Session 2: July 5 - July 14, Session 3: July 17 - July 28

Applications are due by March 15th. Email to summerarts@brooklynfriends.org
Acceptance notifications will go out by April 15th.

Can interns participate in more than one session?

We try to give as many people as possible the opportunity to participate in the Summer Arts Internship Program. If there is an opening in a session, we will then be able to offer a spot to those who want to participate in multiple sessions.

Do you know which art instructor/instructors the intern will be paired with?

After interns are accepted and confirmed, they will be asked to look at the class offerings and indicate their 1st and 2nd choices for the classes they would like to be placed in for the session. Every effort will be made to place interns in one of their two choices, but it is not guaranteed.

Will interns be able to swim at the Marriott with the Summer Arts students?

Yes! Two times per week.
