WHY: An independent Quaker Pre-K through 12th Grade school, BFS is an exemplary institution with over 900 students within its walls. Proceeds from this event, run by the Parent and Teacher Association, support the school in a myriad of ways, including capital improvements, and financial aid. Your contribution is a way to underwrite this acclaimed school where over 25% of the students receive some form of financial aid – over \$5.4 million dollars representing an average of \$6,363 per student each academic year. 36% of the student body is of color and 100% of the students go on to a four-year college or university.

HOW TO GET INVOLVED: This event is a great opportunity to get in front of hundreds of Brooklyn area families. Purchase a vendor space for \$125, then set up a mini pop up and sell food stuff directly to attendees (in \$5 tasting portions so guests can try multiple items).
