## Fifth Grade Supply List 2018-19 (by subject)

### Humanities

- 1 inch, three-ring binder (a sturdy binder with rings that lock is best)
- 6 dividers with writable tabs
- 1 Composition Notebook (no spirals)
- Highlighter

### Math

- Spiral graph-paper notebook
- Sturdy folder with pockets
- Basic calculator. However, the one used in 6th and 7th grade is a Texas Instruments; (**any version** of TI 30), in case you want to get one that you can use later in MS. Please label the calculator and case with a Sharpie or very sticky label.

### Science

- 1 one-inch three-ring binder
- 5 dividers

### Spanish

- 1 spiral-bound notebook, ideally with pockets

### Health

- 1" three-ring binder, with:
- Looseleaf
- 5 dividers

### Chorus

- Water bottle labeled with name

### For use in multiple classes:

- At least 5 pens (blue or black ink)
- A different colored pen for correcting work
- At least 25 pencils (more may be needed during the year) or 5 mechanical pencils
- Erasers
- Personal pencil sharpener
- Colored pencils (a set of 12-24 is good)
- Lined notebook paper (3 holes, wide ruled)
- Reinforcements
- Sturdy, see through, plastic accordion homework portfolio with at least 6 dividers
- Soft zip-up pencil case or pencil box (or you can put a zip-up case in each binder)

### Highly recommended:

#### For school:

- Soft backpack (without frame) that can fit in a locker
- Locker shelf (5th grade lockers are 15" deep, 10" wide, & 30" high)
- Magnets for locker
- Small 3 hole puncher

#### For home:

- Corkboard or bulletin board, dictionary, use of a computer with internet access, calendar, printer

## **Fifth Grade Supply List 2018-19 (by material)**

### **Required**

- 3 one-inch binders
- 3 sets of dividers (for a total of 15-20) with tabs that can be written on
- 1 sturdy, see-through plastic homework portfolio (accordion) with at least 6 dividers
- 1 sturdy 2-pocket folder
- 1 composition notebook (not spiral bound)
- 1 spiral bound notebook (ideally with pockets)
- 1 spiral bound notebook with graph paper
- 1 basic calculator labeled with name (any calculator is fine, but the 6th and 7th grades use the TI 30)
- Lined notebook paper (3 holes, wide ruled)
- Reinforcements for hole punched paper
- Soft, zip-up pencil case
- At least 25 pencils or 5 mechanical pencils
- At least 5 pens (blue or black ink)
- 1 pen in a different color for correcting work
- 1 highlighter
- 1 set of colored pencils (12-24 colors)
- 1 personal pencil sharpener
- Erasers
- 1 water bottle labeled with name

- Pencils - please buy a box of pencils which you will store in the math classroom and use as needed.
- A large eraser
