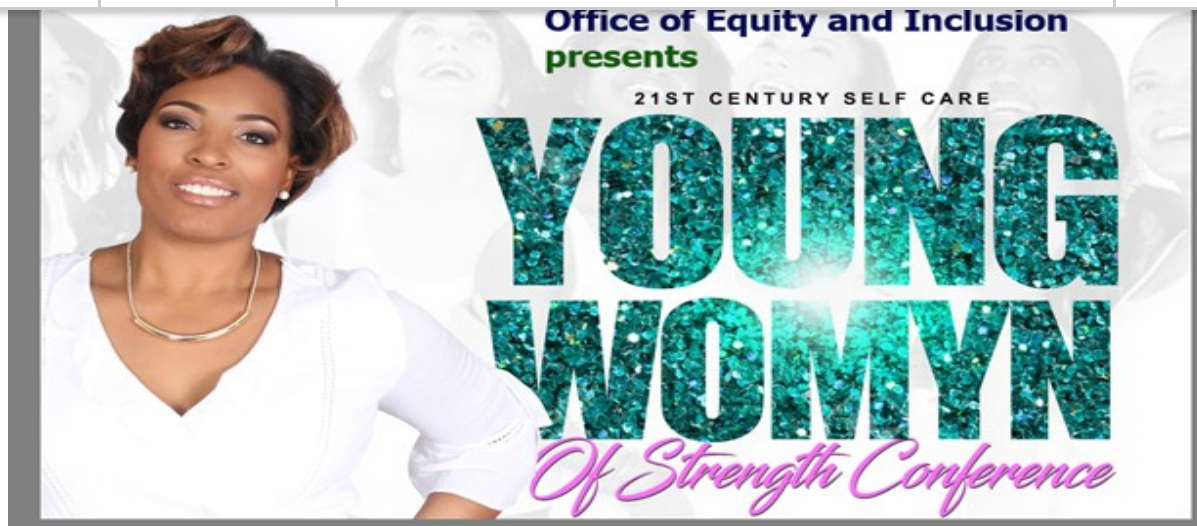
Head of School Candidate Feedback Form

Afterschool Announcements

- **Today, Oct. 19, Preschool Afterschool will end at 5:30pm** so we may prepare for PS Parent Orientation, which begins at 6pm.
- **Nov. 1 is the deadline for Afterschool balances and/or Private Music Lessons.** You may pay with a credit card (3% service fee added) or e check through your [My Backpack](#) account, or send a check payable to Brooklyn Friends School, att: Afterschool. Any outstanding balances after this date will result in discontinued Afterschool classes and/or music lessons.
- The deadline to drop Afterschool classes was Oct 8. Refunds and credits will no longer be given for dropped classes after this date.
- Because of the trip to Nature's Classroom, there is no Afterschool for 4th graders on Oct 24 & 25. If 4th graders return DURING Afterschool hours on the 26th, Afterschool will be provided for them on that day.

Please Help the School maintain a safe environment at Pearl Street during afterschool hours. Unless enrolled in afterschool or in a supervised activity such as sports, rehearsals, library or tutoring, students **need to leave the building promptly** at the time they are dismissed (or by 3:45pm for those waiting in the cafeteria.) Parents/ caregivers need to supervise and accompany their students during dismissal time, especially when waiting for siblings. In no case should students (with or without parents/caregivers) use the rooftop playground, the gym, the space adjacent the meetinghouse, or any other area once the regular school day ends.
